RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Chairman Ronnie Lupe advises the Tribal Council that tribal member, Violet Antonio is requesting assistance with repairs to her home necessitated by fire damage; and
- whereas, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Maintenance Department can provide the labor and material to make the needed repairs at a cost of approximately \$2,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Chairman Lupe that Mrs. Antonio is in need of emergency assistance and that the repairs on Violet Antonio's home should be made by the Tribal Maintenance Department as soon as possible.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Maintenance Department to make the necessary repairs on Violet Antonio's home in an expedient manner.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Maintenance Department shall absorb the cost of materials and labor for said repairs.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 06, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
