## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Tina Cruz has come before the Tribal Council to request assistance for her and her newborn child; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Cruz has recently been released from the hospital with a newborn infant and she does not have firewood to heat her home which is heated entirely by a woodburning stove; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Game & Fish Department has firewood which has been confiscated for various violations; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that with the severe weather conditions, there exists an emergency situation and firewood should be provided to Ms. Cruz.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache
  Game and Fish Department to provide Tina Cruz with a
  sufficient supply of firewood, from its confiscated
  firewood supply, to adequately heat her home during the
  winter months.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 06, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
