RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- pursuant to prior Tribal Council Resolution No. 12-92-261, the Tribal Council directed that the Tribal Council WHEREAS, Secretary post a proposed Gaming Ordinance; and
- the Tribal Council is advised that the proposed Gaming Ordinance was posted in accordance with the requirements WHEREAS, of the Tribal Constitution for a period of at least 10 days in each district for purposes of obtaining public comments; and
- the Tribal Council concludes that said ordinance should WHEREAS, be enacted this date.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts the proposed Gaming Ordinance of the White Mountain Apache Tribe effective this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 12, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (g) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
