## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has approved Resolution No. 3-91-77, which provided for an allowable cut of 625 million board feet based on cutting 14 million board feet from cable ground for the period of 1991 to 2000, to be cut at the rate of 75 million board feet for the first 3 years and 57.1 million board feet for the remaining 7 years; and
- WHEREAS, this rate was established to allow a transition period
  for the Tribe and FATCO to adjust to the reduced annual
  harvest; and
- WHEREAS, the first two years have been very profitable for FATCO and the Tribe due to a good lumber market; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council herewith removes cable ground from contributing to the allowable cut, thereby lowering it to 611 million board feet; and
- whereas, the Natural Resource Committee has recommended that the annual allowable cut for calendar year 1991 be 60.4 million board feet, for calendar year 1992 be 84.7 million board feet, and for calendar years 1993, 1994 and 1995 be reduced to 58.3 million board feet, thereby limiting the total cut for the first five years to 320 million board feet and leaving the annual allowable cut for calendar years 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999 and 2000 at 58.2 million board feet.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the adjustment to the 1991 to 2000 Forest Management Plan cutting, budget, as recommended by the National Resources Commitee.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>January 12, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of  $\underline{six}$  for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
