RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, proposed amendments to the Labor Code have been presented to the Tribal Council by the Legal Department and the TERO Director; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council has reviewed the proposed amendments to the Labor Code and concludes that it would be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to post the proposed amended Labor Code for public comment in each district in accordance with the Constitution.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amended Labor Code for a minimum of ten (10) days in each district in accordance with the Tribal Constitution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 04, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
