RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, by previous resolution, requested the Tribal Election Commission to conduct a study of redistricting and reapportionment on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the terms of the Election Commission have expired; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council wishes to reappoint previous members of the Election Commission for the 1994 General Election and to continue with the study of redistricting and reapportionment: Rayleen Benashley, Myrna Hillyard, Paul Kuehl, Anthony Cooley, Virgil Kessay, Brenda Billy, Virginia Dalton and Hedy Kelewood, for said purposes.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby reappoints Rayleen Benashley, Myrna Hillyard, Paul Kuehl, Anthony Cooley, Virgil Kessay, Brenda Billy, Virginia Dalton and Hedy Kelewood to the Election Commission for the 1994 General Election and until such time as the redistricting and reapportionment study is presented to the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 4, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>one</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
