

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, tribal members, Robinson & Dorothy (Altaha) Alsenay and Ida Lee Kasey have requested Tribal Council approval to sponsor an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of May 21-23, 1993; and

**WHEREAS**, Roger and Vangie Burdette of San Carlos, Arizona have been chosen as Godparents and they have accepted the role; and

**WHEREAS**, arrangements are already underway for the necessary ceremonial activities to be held at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Robinson & Dorothy (Altaha) Alsenay and Ida Lee Kasey, Sponsors, and Roger & Vangie Burdette, Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance during the week-end of May 21-23, 1993 at the Old Fairgrounds in Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on February 04, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
