RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that a BIA access road runs through the middle of tribal member Michael Standing's homesite; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is further advised that Mr. Standing is going to have a house constructed on the premises and is requesting the Tribal Council to remove the road from the BIA road system so that he can build his house on the site; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the road should be closed to allow Mr. Standing to construct his house.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that the road running through Michael Standing's homesite be removed from the BIA access road system.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the portion of the road that does not encroach on Mr. Standing's property remain in use as a BIA access road.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 4, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
