## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that tribal member Queenie Nashio does not have an access road to her homesite area; and
- WHEREAS, Queenie Nashio has requested that the Tribal Council authorize the construction of an all weather access road to her homesite area; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that it is a necessity for the access road to be constructed.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe it hereby approves the construction of an all weather access road to Queenie Nashio's homesite area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Executive Director of the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority to coordinate the construction of the road with the BIA Roads Department.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 4, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
