## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous resolution established a priority list for BIA road construction within the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to place roads on the priority list for the communities of East Fork, North Fork and Cibecue to accommodate future development and land assignments in these communities; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that these roads should be placed on the priority list.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Director to meet with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Road Engineer to coordinate a plan for road systems in the communities of East Fork, North Fork and Cibecue.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the above road priority list shall not take precedence over the previously established priority list nor jeopardize any other road priorities previously set by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 4, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
