RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Chairman of the Law and Order Committee Johnny Endfield advises the Tribal Council that to establish fair representation on the Law and Order Committee, a representative from Cibecue and a representative from Canyon Day should be appointed to the committee; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Endfield recommends the appointment of Nashley Tessay, Sr., of Cibecue, and Nolan Clay, of Canyon Day, to the Law and Order Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with Mr. Endfield's recommendations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Nashley Tessay, Sr. and Nolan Clay to the Law and Order Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 5, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
