

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** Allen Cassa, Jr. and Irene (Alsenay) Cassa, requested that their child, Eileen Allen Cassa who is dually enrolled be granted relinquishment from the White Mountain Apache Tribe, so that she may remain a member of the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the White Mountain Apache Tribal Enrollment Ordinance Chapter 6, Section 1-601, prohibits dual enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and sign by the mother, Irene (Alsenay) Cassa in the presence of a Notary Public on the 3rd day of February, 1993 and are attached hereto.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request from the parents of Eileen Allen Cassa and her membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on March 17, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
