## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council has traditionally purchased Christmas candy with General Tribal Land Claims funds for distribution in each district on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- whereas, the total cost of \$7,892.50 for 10,500 sack of Christmas candy will be paid for by the General Tribal Land Claims fund.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of General Tribal Land claim funds in the amount of \$7,892.50 for the purchase of 10,500 sack of Christmas candy that was distributed in December, 1992.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 17, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
