

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


- WHEREAS,** the Headstart Program received notification of increased funding and expansion for fiscal year 1993, these funds are earmarked for the following categories: cost-of-living increase; quality set-aside; expansion; and one time program improvement; and
- WHEREAS,** there are approximately 754 three and four year old children of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and 54% of these children are low-income and children at risk; and
- WHEREAS,** the Headstart program only serves 192 of the eligible children, which is only 47% of the eligible children of which ten percent of the the Headstart enrollment must be handicapped children; and
- WHEREAS,** parents of these children also need to have parenting skills, complete education and job skills, in order to house these children and programs for the parents, it is necessary for the Tribe to have a match contribution to the total funding of this project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a grant proposal in the amount of \$500,000 to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Service Administration of Children, Youth, Families, and commits a match of tribal contribution in the amount of \$90,000 through the donation of the building and volunteers.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that the Tribal Chairman and/or in his absence the Vice Chairman are authorized to sign all necessary documents relating to said grant.

The foregoing resolution was on March 24 1993, duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for and ZERO against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (j) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
