RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council has received inquires from tribal members who own cattle or wish to become a cattle owners as to which livestock association they should belong to; and
- whereas, members of the Tribal Council have also received complaints or information that most of the livestock associations are not organized, do not have officers, directors, or a designated stockman and that the associations have not conducted an inventory of cattle within their ranges and that there is a general lack of information about the status of the various livestock associations; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that the associations should be directed to be organized in accordance with the Tribal Livestock Ordinance, to elect officers, to conduct an inventory of all cattle within their assigned grazing lands and to provide a report to the General Livestock Association which in turn should provide a report to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs each livestock association
 to organize itself as required by the Tribal Livestock
 and Range Management Ordinance, to elect officers, to
 designate a stockman and to conduct an inventory of all
 cattle by ownership and brand within the grazing land
 assigned to each association.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the associations are directed to provide the names of their elected officers, designated stockman and cattle inventory by owner and brand to the General Livestock Association as soon as possible, and that the General Livestock Association office is directed to provide a summary report of each association to the Tribal Council immediately thereafter.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 07, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
