RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. William Campbell representing the Long Bow Production Studio has requested permission from the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council to film in the area of the Salt River Canyon for a period of four days and for assignment of two Game Rangers to assist the studio and has advised that the studio will be willing to pay the Tribe for the privilege of being allowed to film on the reservation and;
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be granted and that the Tribal Chairman should negotiate a location fee with Mr. Campbell to allow the studio to film on the reservation for a period of four days and for the assignment of two Game Rangers to assist the studio.
- BE IT RESOLVED BY the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that hereby grants permission to Mr. Campbell the Long Bow Production Studio and actors and employees of the studio to utilize the Salt River Canyon area for a period of four days, commencing on or about April 29 and the 30th and for two additional days thereafter.

The foregoing resolution was on April 07, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
