RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Chairman of the San Carlos Apache Tribe have requested a council resolution supporting a proclamation of the National Native American Honor Society proclaiming April 19-23, 1993 as "National Native American Honor Society" week for the White Mountain Apache Tribe and San Carlos Apache Tribe to honor students from both tribes from grades 4 through 12 who have a 4.0 GPA; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council believes that education is one of the strongest allies for its youth and its people in a rapidly changing world and is essential to developing future leadership for the White Mountain Apache and San Carlos Apache Tribes.
- BE IT RESOLVED BY the Tribal Council for the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby adopts the proclamation attached to
 this resolution and incorporated reference herein,
 proclaiming April 19-23, 1993 as "National Native
 American Honor Society" week for the White Mountain
 Apache Tribe and San Carlos Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY the Tribal Council that it hereby supports the effort of the Education Department by sponsoring a banquet on Thursday April 22, 1993, to thank our students for their effort to improve life for all of us.

The foregoing resolution was on April 07, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
