RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Councilmember Johnnie Endfield has come before the Tribal Council this date and advised that Tribal employee, Hupp Sanchez, Jr. has requested permission to transfer 32 hours of sick leave to his wife, Charlotte Sanchez due to medical reasons; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is in agreement that approval should be granted to transfer sick leave to Charlotte Sanchez as requested.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of 32 hours of sick leave earned by Hupp Sanchez, Jr. to Charlotte Sanchez.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Personnel Department to process the transfer of 32 hours of sick leave pursuant to this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 12, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
