RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the White Mountain Apache Tribe in 1992 accepted a grant in the amount of \$296,000 from the Commission on National Services for the American Conservation and Youth Service Corps (ACYSC) Program to establish a Conservation and Community Youth Service Corps within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Arizona Conservation Corps (ACC) is willing to establish a Cooperative Agreement with the White Mountain Apache Tribe wherein ACC will provide supervisory assistance, technical assistance, and training services to the ACYSC Program and its participants; and
- whereas, the ACYSC Program is willing and interested in establishing the Cooperative Agreement to benefit and enhance the services that may be provided to the ACYSC Program participants and the communities the Program serves; and
- WHEREAS, the ACYSC Program and the Tribal Legal Department is currently working with the Arizona Conservation Corps to establish the terms and responsibilities of the Cooperative Agreement for the ACYSC and the ACC Programs, respectively; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that the agreement would be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Legal Department is directed to work with the ACYSC Program and the ACC to draft a Cooperative Agreement that will be beneficial to the Tribe and its communities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to negotiate with the Arizona Conservation Corps the final terms of the Cooperative Agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 12, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
