RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the White Mountain Apache Headstart Program received notification of funding for the following Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Programs for fiscal year 1993, Parent Aide Services and Community Education and Information; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Headstart Program received funds for a similar program from the Arizona Department of Economic Security for fiscal year 1992; and
- whereas, said funds will be used to educate the community on child abuse and neglect prevention, provide parenting skills and coordinate with other agencies and departments to reduce incidents of child abuse and neglect;
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a grant proposal for the above program in the amount of \$40,000 (the maximum amount allocated) to the Arizona Department of Economic Security and that these funds will also be used as a match for a federal Head Start grant.

The foregoing resolution was on April 12, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
