


**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Ms. Gwendolyn Hammers has requested enrollment for her daughter Andolyn Jo Tillman, DOB: 02/09/1991, with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Andolyn Jo Tillman's enrollment application and supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS,** the Enrollment Committee finds that Andolyn Jo Tillman eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of 1/2 White Mountain Apache through her mother Gwendolyn Hammers.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the recommendation of the Enrollment Committee, that the enrollment of Andolyn Jo Tillman is hereby granted membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on April 12, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article III, Section 3 of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
