- WHEREAS, Fred Banashley, Sr., who served as Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe from 1970-1974, passed away on April 23, 1993; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to acknowledge his past devoted service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and its people; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, as a tribute to Fred Banashley, Sr., wishes to donate one beef for the wake services, and the amount of \$3,000.00 to assist with funeral and burial expenses.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby donates one beef for the wake services, and \$3,000.00 to assist with the funeral and burial expenses of former Tribal Chairman, Fred Banashley, Sr.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it has assumed these expenses in honor of its fellow tribal member and leader, and in remembrance of his good deeds and works for the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 27, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
