

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** tribal members, Gabriel and Ida Garland have asked the Tribal Council for assistance for housing; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. and Mrs. Garland have advised the Tribal Council that they have been applying for Mutual Help housing for approximately five years and feel that they are not getting any consideration from the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs White Mountain Apache Housing Authority Director Franklin Quintero to investigate the housing application of Gabriel and Ida Garland and report back to the Tribal Council at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of five for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
