RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Lucero Suttle has come before the Tribal Council to request permission to start a towing business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the ownership of local businesses by tribal members is to be encouraged and supported by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that the business venture proposed by Mr. Suttle is in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and will contribute to the overall development of the local economy.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Tribal Member, Lucero Suttle, to start a towing business on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
