RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Members have requested that the Tribal Council approve funding for the construction of four baseball fields at the old lagoon; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council fully supports the Little League program and concurs that the matter should be further investigated.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Planning and Engineering Department to do a feasibility and cost study on the construction of two Senior League and two Little League Baseball fields at the old lagoon.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning and Engineering Department is directed to report its findings to the Tribal Council upon completion of the feasibility/cost study.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
