RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal Member, Serinda Goseyun has come before the Tribal Council on behalf of all little league baseball teams on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, with a request for assistance in the form of a monetary contribution towards the purchase of baseball supplies for all little league teams; and
- WHEREAS, the amount needed to purchase the necessary supplies for all little league teams totals \$441.90; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has agreed to contribute one-half the amount necessary.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby contributes the amount of \$220.95 towards the purchase of necessary supplies for the little league teams located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that funds for the requested supplies shall be taken from the Tribal Council account.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
