RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the White Mountain Apache Tribe Education Department received a request for a proposal (RFP) for the Indian Vocational Education Training at Apache Skill Center from the U.S. Department of Education, through its Indian Vocational Education Training Program for fiscal year 1993; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is working on establishing local certified office practice, building trade and vocational rehabilitation training for its Apache people under the direction of Tribal Education Department; and
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Education has, through its Indian Vocational Education Training Program, \$6,588,641 in funding for the first year of a three-year grant; and
- whereas, the purpose of the program is to plan, conduct and administer projects, or portions of projects, that are authorized by and consistent with the purposes of the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Applied Technology Education Act of 1990; and
- WHEREAS, approximately twenty-six (26) projects will be funded; and
- whereas, the primary purpose of the program is training, planning, administering certification and employment; and
- whereas, grant funds will be used to plan and conduct training programs, provide job placement services as well as administration and coordination of placement for young adults with agencies and departments in order to reduce unemployment and increase employment with certified trained young Apaches.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a grant proposal for the above program to the U.S. Department of Education, Washington, D.C.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Education Department is authorized to prepare and submit the application on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
