

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, severe and extensive storms were experienced on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation during the period of December, 1992 - March, 1993. These storms caused substantial damage to numerous facilities and utilities, irrigation systems, levees, roads, dams, livestock tanks and reservation streambanks; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed by the Bureau that approximately \$4.8 million dollars are tentatively planned for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for flood repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council appointed a committee by Resolution No. 04-93-069 to plan and implement the utilization of the \$4.8 million dollars tentatively planned for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has met and developed preliminary work plans, personnel, and equipment for utilization of the \$4.8 million dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Committee recommends a Public Law 93-638 cooperative agreement be entered into between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the White Mountain Apache Tribe for emergency flood repair, mitigation, and control.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman, Vice Chairman, or designated representative of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to negotiate, enter into and modify a cooperative agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for emergency flood repair, mitigation, and control.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the cooperative agreement shall commence as soon as possible, no later than June 1, 1993 and continue for twelve months, with provisions for extensions if so warranted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the administration of this program be coordinated with the committee established by Tribal Council Resolution No. 04-93-069.

The foregoing resolution was on May 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) (h) (j) (k) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
