RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-91-60, dated February 21, 1991, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe requested that community streets be reconstructed; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous right-of-way of 80 feet wide for a length of 3.231 miles as shown on right-of-way drawings as follows:

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 05, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
