

RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previous Resolution No. 02-92-060 established priorities for new roads in communities; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council by previous Resolution No. 05-93-113 granted right-of-ways for roads to be constructed by FAIR Consolidated No. 21; and
- whereas, the Bureau of Indian Affairs needs to designate areas to be used as borrow pits to construct the roads on FAIR Consolidated No. 21.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the Bureau of Indian Affairs permission for the use of the attached four borrow pit locations.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>May 18, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




Borrow Pit #2
