RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Education Committee advises the Tribal Council that the current approved College Work Study Program budget only allows seventy students to be employed for five (5) weeks for an average of \$850.00 per student and that there are approximately 195 college students either in school or about to be enrolled in college next year; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Department and Tribal Education Committee proposes to the Tribal Council that the College Work Study Program be increased in the amount of \$195,000 which would permit 150 students to be enrolled in the program for ten (10) weeks for an average of \$1,700.00 per students; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council agrees that the Tribal budget should be amended in the amount \$195,000 in order to fully fund the College Work Study Program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby amends the Tribal budget in the amount of \$195,000 in order to fund the College Work Study Program in the amount of \$255,000.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Chairman, and in his absence the Vice Chairman and any necessary Tribal officials, are hereby authorized to execute any budget amendment documents necessary to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (k) he Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
