

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council adopted Resolution No. 04-93-068 concerning the reorganizing of our livestock associations; and
- WHEREAS,** each livestock association has operated on its own for quite some time without guidance and direction; and
- WHEREAS,** training has been requested for the newly elected officers; and
- WHEREAS,** it would be to the benefit of each livestock association and the General Livestock Association and its members to have organizational skills and goals of their own for their direction and success; and
- WHEREAS,** each association needs assistance with organization and bylaws, goals, economics, bookkeeping and management.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves a proposal for the training of the officers of each livestock association and the General Livestock Office, and calls for this training to occur over the next 12 months conducted by EARC, commencing in July. It will culminate in the adoption of updated, formal goals and bylaws by each of the livestock associations and the General Livestock Association, as well.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that each association must have officers elected and a stockman by July 1, 1993. And, the deadline for livestock inventory by ownership and brand from each livestock association shall be September 15, 1993.

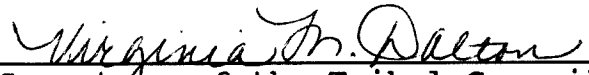
The foregoing resolution was on June 09, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of four for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
