RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council by previously resolution authorized funding for construction of a building for the Tribal Employment Rights Office; and
- WHEREAS, permission for use of the land assigned to the Tribal Education Department is necessary so that TERO can construct a building in an area set aside for educational purposes next to the Skill Center; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be approved for the TERO building on land set aside for educational purposes with the understanding that it will not be a permanent place for the TERO office and that after TERO vacates the building it will become the property of the education department.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it hereby grants permission for the Tribal Employment Rights Office to construct a building on land set aside for the Education Department next to the Skill Center, said land to be surveyed by the Tribal Land Office.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 09, 1993</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
