RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is vitally concerned about the safety, health and welfare of its tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, Arizona State Highway No. 73 traverses the Fort Apache Indian Reservation from Indian Pine to Carrizo Junction, and United States Highway No. 60 traverses the Fort Apache Indian Reservation from Forestdale to the Salt River Canyon; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is aware of traffic related problems on these highways and desires to obtain funds for prevention education for Tribal members residing on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council has been notified of funds available to implement prevention projects to educate the people on bicycle safety, defensive driving, pedestrian safety and usage of safety restraints; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that a Grant Proposal for highway safety should be submitted to the Governor's Office of Highway Safety, and that the Tribal Health Authority and Tribal Police Department should work together to implement the program if it is awarded to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Cibecue CHR Supervisor under the Tribal Health Authority to prepare the grant application and proposal for submission to the Governor's Office of Arizona Highway Safety.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Tribal Chairman Ronnie Lupe, or in his absence, Vice Chairman Lafe Altaha are hereby authorized and delegated to review and sign the application and any required grant forms in order to complete the grant application.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 09, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
