

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is vitally concerned about the health and welfare of its tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware of gaps of critical services for the Apache people and desires to obtain funds to establish an Emergency Shelter to provide temporary and transitional shelter for homeless Tribal members and their family members;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been notified of the availability of competitive grant applications for American Indian/Alaska Natives; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that a Emergency Shelter Grant proposal should be submitted to the HUD Offices of Indian Programs in Phoenix, and that the Tribal Health Authority, Tribal Interagency Coordinating Committee and Tribal Social Services should work together to implement the program if it is awarded to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Health Authority and IACC to prepare the Emergency Shelter grant application and proposal for submission to the HUD Office of Indian Programs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Chairman Ronnie Lupe, or in his absence Vice Chairman Lafe Altaha, are hereby authorized and delegated to review and sign the application and any required grant forms in order to complete the grant application.

The foregoing resolution was on June 09, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
