RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, renovation and repair of facilities for the Tribal Fair and Rodeo are required for reasons of appearance and safety; and
- WHEREAS, a successful Tribal Fair and Rodeo requires safe facilities and a positive public image for the Tribe and for thousands of visitors attending the Tribe's annual Fair and Rodeo; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested by the Fair and Rodeo Committee to waive all Tribal Department and Enterprise fees for the renovation and repair of the Fair and Rodeo facilities and the Tribal Council concurs in this request.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Chairman to
 notify in writing all Tribal Departments and Enterprises
 to waive all fees and costs for materials or labor
 necessary to renovate and repair Fair and Rodeo
 facilities.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 16, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
