RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, due to the resignation of Juvenile Judge Anna Goseyun, there is a vacancy on the bench of the Juvenile Court; and
- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee has recommended to the Tribal Council that Durango Fall be appointed as Juvenile Judge of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Durango Fall has ten years experience working with the Judicial system and is well qualified to assume the responsibilities of the Juvenile Judge position; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that Durango Fall is fully qualified and capable of filling the judicial vacancy.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Durango Fall to the position of Juvenile Judge of the White Mountain Apache Juvenile Court for the duration of Judge Anna Goseyun's term pursuant to Section 2.13 of the Judicial Code.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 16, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
