RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is empowered to WHEREAS, prescribe the duties and powers of all Legislative Committees; and
- the Tribal Council has recognized a need to have WHEREAS, purposes, powers and duties of the Law and Order Committee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe clearly delineated; and
- WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee has prepared and recommends the adoption of a Plan of Operation for the Law and Order Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has reviewed the Plan of Operation for the Law and Order Committee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts the Plan of Operation for the Law and Order Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on June 16, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (k) (s) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
