## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the State Parks Department has announced that grant funds are available for creating and establishing trails; and
- the Fort Apache Historic District Master Plan identified WHEREAS. a need for trails in the historic district; and
- the trail from behind Officer's Row across East Fork to WHEREAS, the site of the original Scout's Row was identified as the top priority; and
- the total estimated cost of the Tribal is \$15,000; and WHEREAS,
- the required 50/50 match can be supplied by JTPA workers. WHEREAS,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a grant application for funding for the Scout's Row Trail.

The foregoing resolution was on June 16, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) (j) (k) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
