RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- Councilmember Randall Massey, Jr. brings to the Tribal WHEREAS. Council's attention that tribal member, Hazard Walker should be placed on the HIP priority list due to his particular personal circumstance; and
- Mr. Massey recommends to the Tribal Council that Hazard WHEREAS, Walker be placed on the HIP priority list because he is a handicapped elder in great need of shelter; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised as to details of Mr. Walker's circumstance which establishes a basis for him being placed on the HIP priority list.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal member, Hazard Walker be placed on the HIP priority list.

The foregoing resolution was on June 16, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
