RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has received federal funds for flood damage suffered by several communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and
- whereas, there is a need for a coordinator to be appointed for the scheduling and supervision of repairs to roads, bridges, river banks and other flood damage eligible to be repaired or restored with federal flood damage funds; and
- WHEREAS, Harry Brewer has been recommended to be appointed as Flood Damage Director; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in the recommendation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Harry Brewer as the manager and director of the flood damage program which will utilize federal flood damage funds for the repair and restoration of flood damage property on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 23, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
