## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. & Mrs. Joyner George have requested enrollment of their adoptive daughter, Desiree Jean George, DOB: 12/16/88, with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Desiree Jean George's enrollment application and supporting documents; and
- whereas, the Enrollment Committee finds that Desiree Jean George is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of 1/2 White Mountain Apache through descedancy.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
  Tribe that it hereby grants Desiree Jean George
  membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on
  the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 30, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
