## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the BIA Agency Superintendent, that the agency is willing to transfer title to the Fort Apache Post Office to the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has adopted a master plan for the restoration of Fort Apache, and the transfer of title of the Fort Apache Post Office to the White Mountain Apache Tribe comports with said master plan; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to accept the transfer of title of the Fort Apache Post Office to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that it hereby accepts transfer of title of the Fort Apache Post Office to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs and authorizes the Tribal Chairman to negotiate the terms of a lease with the United States Postal Service for the Ft. Apache Post Office.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 30, 1993</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>five</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) (h) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
