RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has met this date with the Tribal Education Department to review the department's Higher Education Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the written Policy and Procedures Manual for the Higher Education Program, which outlines procedures for administration by the Tribal Education Department of Scholarship Assistance and Educational Opportunities for students; and
- whereas, after careful review of the Policy and Procedures Manual presented to the Tribal Council, The Council concludes that parts 1 and 2 of said policy and procedures should be adopted by the Tribal Council on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby adopts part 1 and 2 of the Policy and Procedures Manual for the White Mountain Apache Tribal Higher Education Program.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 30, 1993</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>four</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
