RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Regina Baca has come before the Tribal Council and requested a waiver of the trailer space fee presently being charged her by the McNary Housing Authority; and
- WHEREAS, the Council is advised that the Council has allowed Tribal Members to reside in the homes without paying rent and in some cases, ownership to said homes have been transferred to Tribal Members; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council concludes that the trailer space rental fees should be waived and that the Tribal Attorney should consult with the Director of the McNary Housing Authority, Matthew Hinton, and make inquiry as to why Regina Baca is being charged trailer space rental fees.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby waives the trailer space rental fee for Regina Baca.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Attorney is directed to consult with Matthew Hinton and to advise him of the waiver of the trailer space rental fee and to inquire about the overall policy for rentals under the McNary Housing Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 14, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 State. 984).
