RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is applying for HOME grant assistance funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to further the supply of housing for low income families; and
- WHEREAS, the undersigned as the governing body of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have voted to adopt, and do adopt, as evidenced by their signatures affixed hereunder, the following resolution.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe agrees to comply with all terms and conditions expressed in HUD's Notice announcing applications for HOME grant assistance, applicable provisions of 24 CFR part 92, Home Investment Partnership Program, provisions of any grant agreement entered into with HUD, and any other stipulations made by HUD and agreed to in writing by a duly authorized representative of this organization pertaining to the grant assistance provided by HUD.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 14, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (h) (i) (j) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
