BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Lynn & Alverna
(Tortice) Cody, Sponsors, and Jeff & Josephine Smith,
Godparents, to hold an Apache Ceremonial Sunrise Dance
during the week-end of August 13-15, 1993 at Carrizo
Canyon.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 14, 1993</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (g) (i) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
