RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member, Alvin Declay has come before the Tribal Council this date with a complaint that he was wrongfully terminated from his employment with the Tribal Game & Fish Department; and
- WHEREAS, Personnel Grievance Procedures is not available to Mr. Declay because he was not a full time employee; and
- the Tribal Council concludes that in fairness requires WHEREAS, that the Tribal Council have the benefit of hearing all sides to the complaint and accordingly Mr. Declay's supervisors should file a report as to the reasons for Mr. Declay's termination with the Tribal Council within ten (10) days of receipt of this resolution.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Alvin Declay's supervisors at the Game & Fish Department to file a report as to the reasons for Mr. Declay's termination with the Tribal Council through the office of the Tribal Council Chairman, with copies to the Tribal Council within ten (10) days of receipt of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on August 04, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (i) (s) (t) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
