RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- whereas, Lonnie and Valeria Ethelbah have requested permission from the Tribal Council to operate an auto repair and body shop business on their residential property; and
- whereas, the Tribal Council is agreeable to granting their request but directs the Ethelbahs to check with the Legal Department to insure that there are no zoning restrictions because the shop will be operating in a residential area.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants permission to Lonnie and Valeria Ethelbah to operate an auto repair and body shop within the confines of their residential property, unless such operation would be restricted by any zoning restriction applicable to a residential area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby advises Lonnie and Valeria Ethelbah to request the Tribal Legal Department to advise them of any restrictions and applicable laws pertaining to Tribal operated businesses.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 4, 1993</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
