

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the expressed legislative intent of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in Resolution No. 06-92-171 was to mandate that non-member attorneys who desire to practice before the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe be licensed by and be a member of the State Bar of Arizona; and

**WHEREAS,** an issue has been raised whether Ordinance No. 179 as written applies to non-member attorneys licensed to practice before the Tribal Court prior to July 1, 1992; and

**WHEREAS,** to enact the Tribal Council's intent, the amendments attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein are necessary to ensure that licensed non-member attorneys practicing before the White Mountain Apache Tribal Court are familiar with the laws of Arizona, as the White Mountain Apache Tribe has incorporated and adopted sections of the Arizona Revised Statutes into the White Mountain Apache Law and Order Code and to otherwise protect the public interest by regulating the conduct of non-member attorneys representing tribal members or non-members, in or outside of Tribal Court on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Judicial Code be amended pursuant to the attached Proposed Ordinance.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amendments to the Judicial Code as provided in the attached Proposed Ordinance for a period of ten (10) days in each district, as required by the Tribal Constitution and Bylaws.

The foregoing resolution was on August 05, 1993, duly adopted by a vote of four for and one against one abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) (o) (q) (s) (t) (u) of the Amended Constitution and Bylaws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
